RULES FOR ADMISSION

➤ GENERAL RULES OF ADMISSION

1. Admission must be taken in person by submitting duly filled up application form, mandatory minimum attendance and by depositing the prescribed fees.
2. All admission shall be provisional subject to confirmation from the Principal and Karnataka State Law University.
3. Documents to be submitted.
 - i. Original statement of marks along with true copy
 - ii. Passing certificate and its true copy
 - iii. Migration certificate in case of the applicant migrating from another university.
 - iv. Transfer certificate
 - v. Three I-card size recent photographs.

❖ RESERVATION:

Students seeking benefit of reservation must produce original documents of the caste certificate. If the students seeks admission and benefits in categories reserved other than for backward classes, a valid and subsisting certificate from the appropriate authority indicating that the student belongs to such category.

❖ **ELIGIBILITY RULES:**

1. THREE YEARS DEGREE LAW COURSE

An applicant who has graduated in any discipline of knowledge from a university established by an Act of Parliament or by a State legislature or an equivalent national institution recognised as a deemed to be university or foreign university recognised as equivalent to the status of an Indian University by an authority competent to declare equivalence, may apply for a three year degree program in Law leading to conferment of LL.B degree on successful completion of the regular programme conducted by university whose degree in Law is recognised by the Bar council of India for the purpose of enrolment.

A student passing Bachelor's degree examination with minimum 45% marks in any faculty in any recognised university shall be eligible for admission to the first year of 3 years LL.B. course. There shall be relaxation of 5% marks in case of SC/ST students.

Ref: (Rule 5(a) of Bar Council of India Rules of Legal Education, 2008).

2. INTEGRATED FIVE YEAR DEGREE LAW COURSE (B.A.,LL.B)

An applicant who has successfully completed senior secondary school course (+2) / P.U.C from a recognized university of India or outside or from a senior secondary board or equivalent, constituted or recognized by the Union or by State Government or from any equivalent institution from a foreign country recognized by the government of that country for the purpose of issue of qualifying certificate on successful completion of the course.

A student passing (+2 / P.U.C) examination with minimum 45% marks in any faculty in any recognized university shall be eligible for admission to the first year of 5 years B.A., LL.B. course. There shall be relaxation of 5% marks in case of SC/ST students.

3. MINIMUM MARKS IN QUALIFYING EXAMINATION FOR ADMISSION:-

Bar council of India may from time to time, stipulate the minimum percentage of marks not below 45% of the total marks in case of general category applicants and 40% of the total marks in case of SC and ST applicants, to be obtained for the qualifying examination.

Provided that such a minimum qualifying marks shall not automatically entitle a person to get admission into an institution but only shall entitle the person concerned to fulfill other institutional criteria notified by the institution concerned or by the University concerned from time to time to apply for admission.

(Rule 7 of Bar Council of India Rules of Legal Education, 2008)

4. AGE FOR ADMISSION

The maximum age limit for admission into 3 years and 5 years law courses specified by Bar Council of India at Clause-28, Schedule-III, Rule 11 of the Rules of Legal Education, 2008 has been withdrawn by the Bar council of India.

5. HOW TO APPLY

Candidates are advised to read the prospectus carefully before filling the application form. Eligible candidates are required to submit the duly filled prescribed application form and prescribed fee with the following enclosures;

6. APPLICATION FORM

- A. The Application form should be filled in Capital Letters only.
- B. Please provide all the available information under appropriate sections/ columns.
- C. Paste the recent pass port size photograph in particular place and self attested photo in the required column.
- D. Sign the application form and put left hand Thumb Impression in the prescribed column.

IMPORTANT

(a) This application is a key part of the admission process. Complete and accurate answers to the questions are therefore extremely important. Incomplete or false information will adversely affect candidate's chances of selection.

(b) In all matters regarding selection of admission for Candidate, College decision will be final. No correspondence will be entertained regarding non-selection of the candidate.

NOTE

Candidate seeking admission to the LL.B course and those admitted to such course shall pay the tuition and other fees as prescribed by the University from time to time. The fee once paid will be not be refunded in any case of cancelling of admission and any circumstance. Once candidate gets admitted he/she is liable to pay fees for the entire course.

INFRASTRUCTURE

Al-Ameen College of Law in order to create excellent and suitable learning environment has adopted a policy by providing various sorts of physical facilities for both lecturers and students. Effective teaching learning is not possible without adequate physical facilities to the students and lecturers. The college is known not only for its academic excellence, quality lecturers, law students, but also has best infrastructural facilities. The college has well equipped class rooms with black board and white boards, LCD, library along with digital library, and campus with Wi-Fi connections.

The policy of the college is to enhance the existing infrastructure and add new amenities to facilitate effective teaching and learning. The college, over the years, has supplemented its existing infrastructure by, construction of bridge between Block 'A' and 'B' renovated library, a seminar hall and ladies room.

Class Rooms: There are 11 class rooms sufficient to conduct the courses.

Technology Enabled Learning Spaces: For effective teaching, all classrooms are upgraded with technology. Communication medium is also enhanced through LCD Projectors, laptops, internet accessibility with LAN connection and Wi-Fi connection.

Moot court Hall :- A separate Moot court Hall having a seating capacity of 60 people

Seminar Hall: Seminar hall have the seating capacity of 150 people along with LCD Projector facility.

Tutorial Spaces: Tutorials are conducted in the seminar hall, class rooms and language lab.

Laboratories: The College has well equipped language lab and computer lab in the library. English coaching classes, specialized facilities and equipment for teaching, learning and research etc. are also provided to the students.

Specialized facilities and equipment for teaching: There are LCD projectors and internet (Wi-Fi and wired) connectivity, well equipped and language lab.
