At the adopted village, Harohalli, legal survey and legal awareness programme was conducted on 14th February 2023. About 35 students reached the village along with 3

While conducting the survey the villagers were informed to participate in the legal awareness programme which was conducted in the afternoon. Around 4 p.m. the formal legal awareness programme was started in which around 65 villagers were participated. Mr. Mohammed Tabrez Alam Shariff, Coordinator, District Legal Services Authority, Bengaluru Rural was the resource person. Mr. Arun Kumar, Grampanchayat Member was the Chief Guest and Mr. Syed Munavar S.I, Advocate, High Court of Karnataka was the Guest of Honour. The programme was presided by Dr. Waseem Khan M.I, Principal. The resource person of the programme explained the villagers about the free legal aid services available at the Legal Services Authority and procedure to avail the same. The flex banner/board containing the information and contact details of the legal services authorities was affixed at the Grampanchayat office and the villagers were asked to take the benefits of the same. 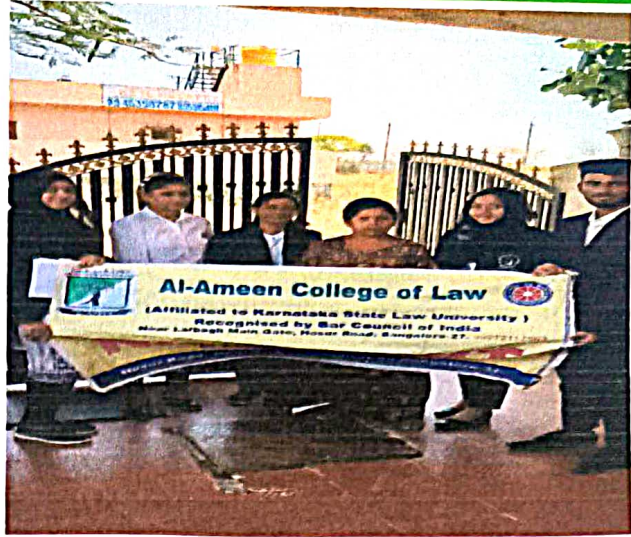

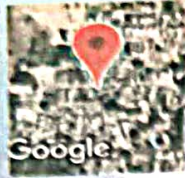

The legal survey and legal awareness programme at Kannaikana Agrahara village was conducted on 27th February 2023. About 37 students reached the village along with 4 faculty members including the coordinators around 10:30 a.m. in the morning. A group of two students was formed to conduct the survey and the students covered 100 households of the village. While conducting the survey the villagers were informed to participate in the legal awareness programme which was conducted in the afternoon. Around 4:00 p.m. the formal legal awareness programme was started in which around 50 villagers were participated. Mr. Vinay Chandra, District Judge and Asst. Secretary, Karnataka State Legal Services Authority, Bengaluru was the resource person. Ms. Mala, Vice President of Bannerughatta Grampanchayat was the Chief Guest and Mr. M.K. Metri, Advocate, High Court of

Karnataka was the Guest of Honour. The programme was presided by Dr. Waseem Khan M.I, Principal. The Resorce person of the programme Mr. Vinay Chandra while addressing the gathering explained in detail the Fundamental Rights and Directive Principles of State Policy with special reference to Article 39A of the Constitution i.e., free legal aid to the poor and weaker section of the society. Sir explained the Salient features of the Legal Services Authorities Act 1987 and the Structure and functions of various legal services authorities from national level to the taluka level under the Act. Sir concluded his speech requesting all to spread the legal awareness amongst the poor masses and the needy people and to avail the services of the legal services authorities. The flex banner/board containing the information and contact details of the legal services authorities was affixed at the compound of the Anganwadi Kendra. All the villgers were asked to take the benefits of the same. The programme was concluded at 6:15 p.m.

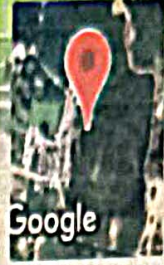
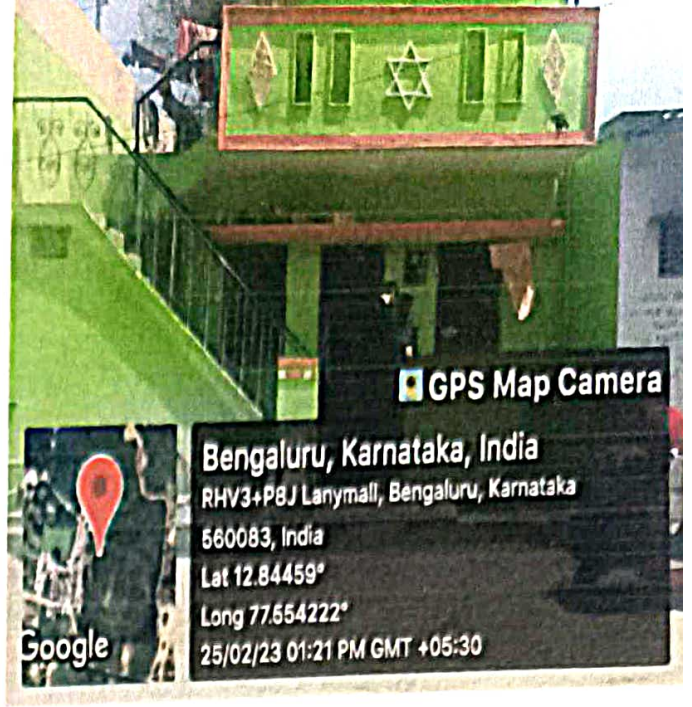
