5. Commencement, renewal, termination and amendment

This MOU will come into force upon affixing of the signatures of the representatives of the both organizations and will remain in effect for three (3) years. This MOU will be renewed upon its expiry, as per mutual agreement of both PARTIES. If either organization wishes to terminate the MOU at the end of the three years' period or in between the period of three years, it must notify the other PARTY not less than six months prior to the expiry of the

MOU. The event of termination will not affect participants from completing their activities at the host party already initiated or ongoing unless otherwise mutually agreed. This MoU, its renewal and the actions taken under it will be reviewed at any time. Modifications to MoU will be made by mutual consent and any amendment or extension to the MoU will be formalized by the exchange of letters and or emails between the two organizations.

6. Coordinators:

Each organization agrees to appoint an overall Coordinator for the administration of this MOU. The Coordinator will serve as the contact person on campus. These coordinators will ensure smooth flow of communication and would be responsible to ensure that necessary approvals are in place for student/faculty programmes etc. These coordinators will be responsible to ensure the effectiveness and enforcement MOU. 2. Both institutions agree and Indivior to promote collaborative activities in academic areas of mutual interest on the basis of equality and reciprocity.



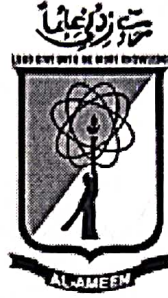
