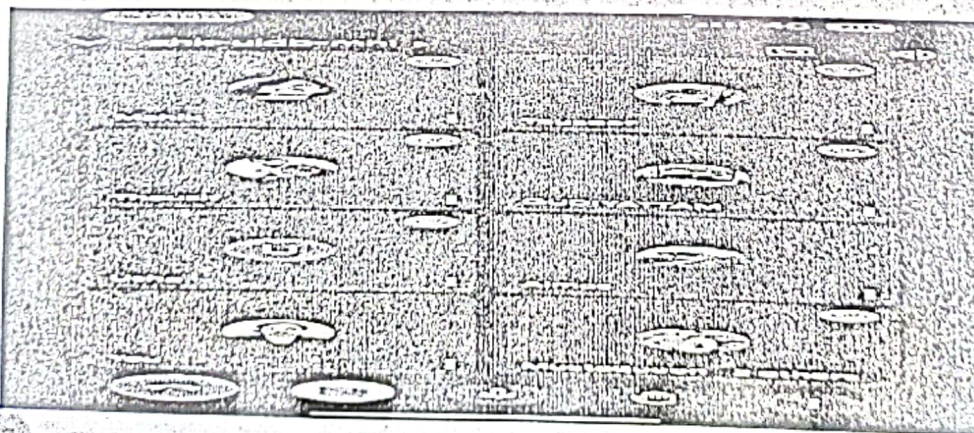
INTRODUCTION:

Emphasis is laid on capturing diverse perspectives, ensuring a comprehensive representation across demographics such as gender, age, and ethnicity. Furthermore, unlike its quantitative counterpart, qualitative research doesn't adhere to a rigid sample size, aiming instead for 'data saturation', where subsequent data doesn't introduce new insights.

Through a balanced combination of methodological rigor and ethical integrity, qualitative research seeks to offer in-depth, meaningful perspectives on specific subjects



OBJECTIVE OF THE SEMINAR

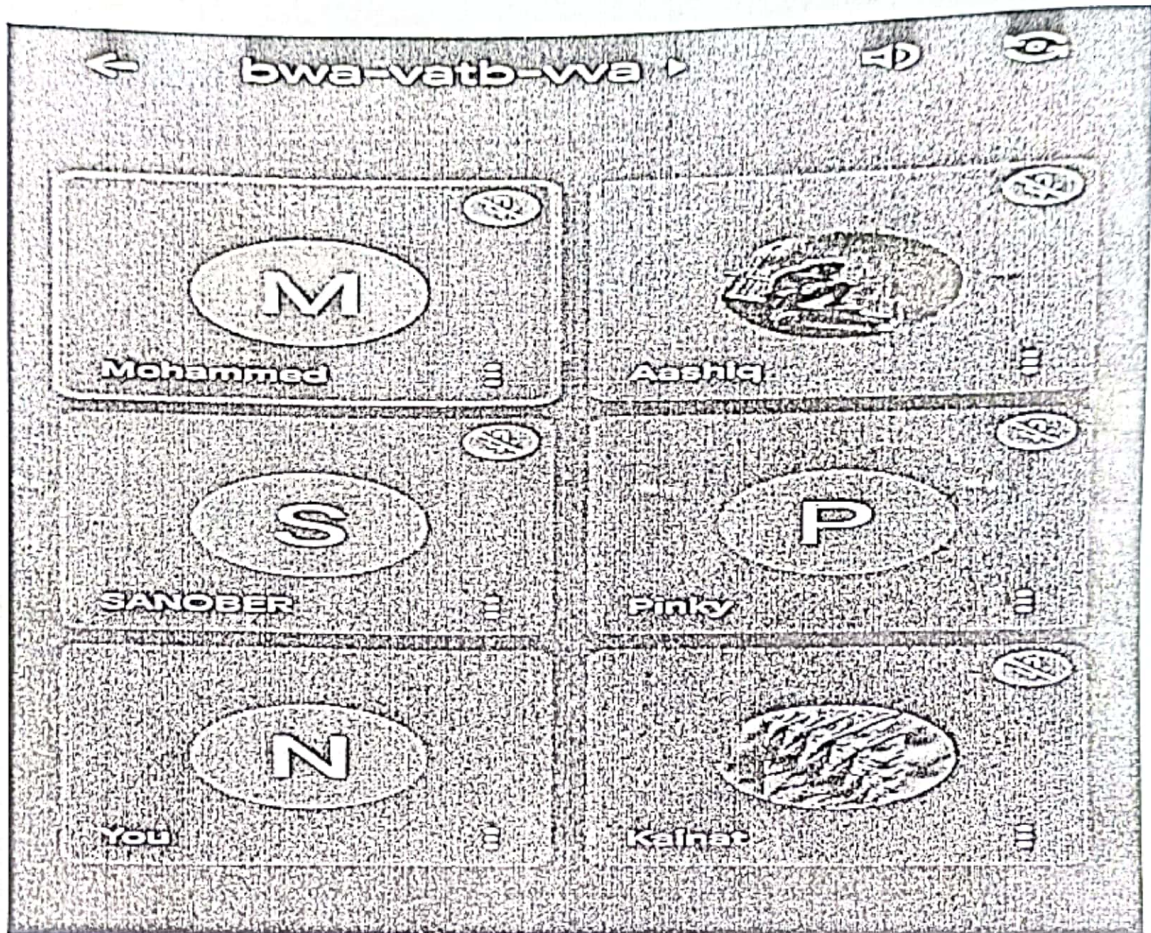

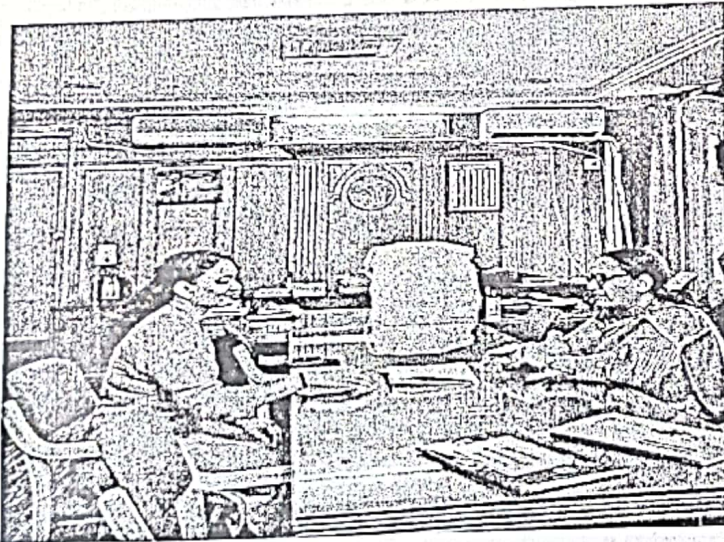

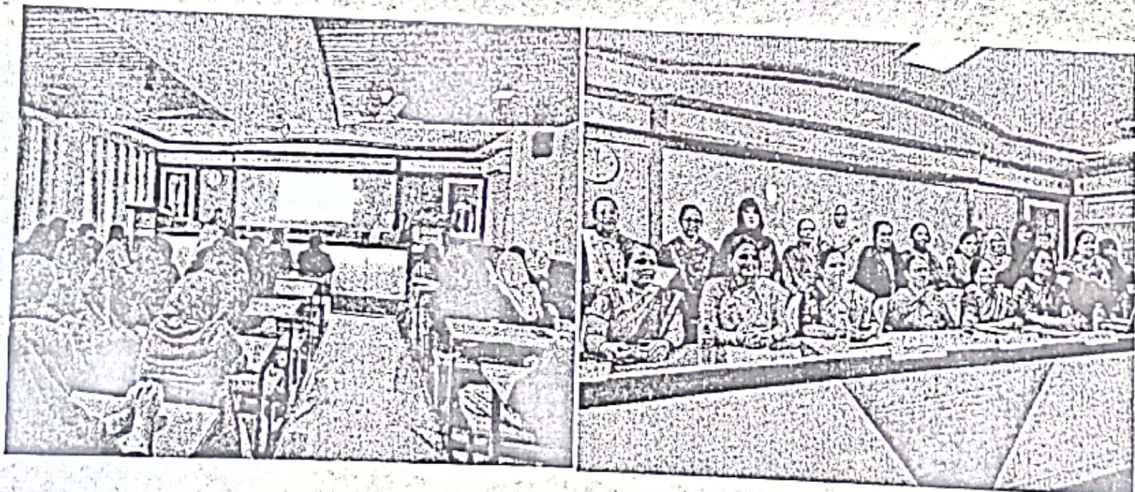

- Gender in equality is an issue to be explained, debated and spoken about





Emergency Helpline numbers has been shared so that the cases of domestic violence and child abuse can be shared, this was followed

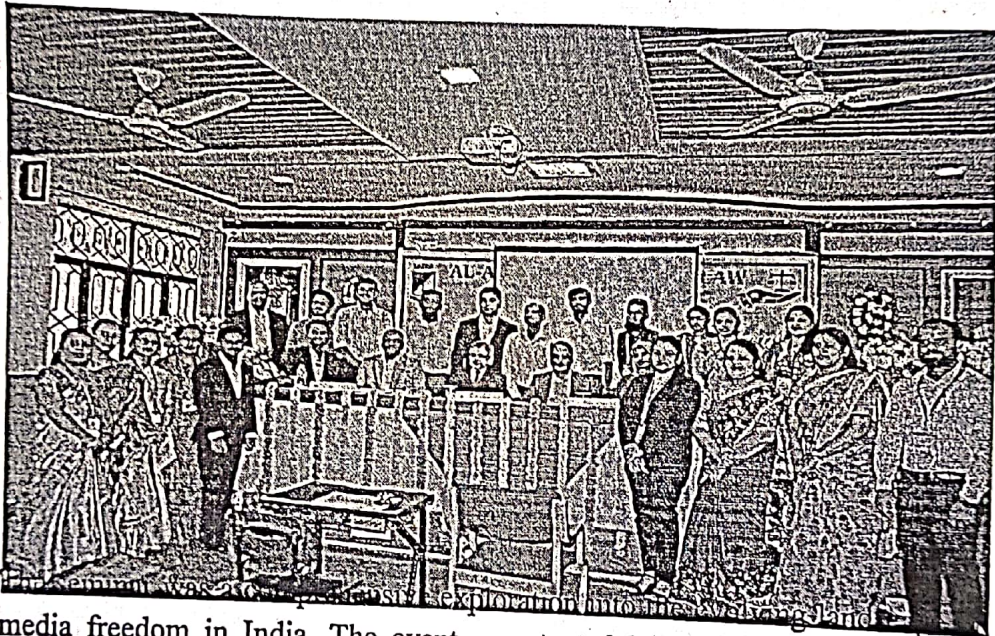
**"FREEDOM OF EXPRESSION IN MEDIA: CHALLENGES

5. Technical Session – II



6. Valedictory Programme






